Day Seven! – It Is Friday

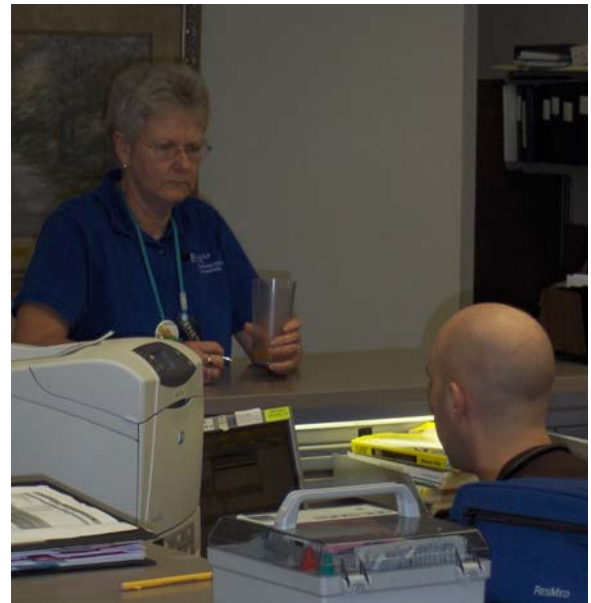
